NICENE CREED

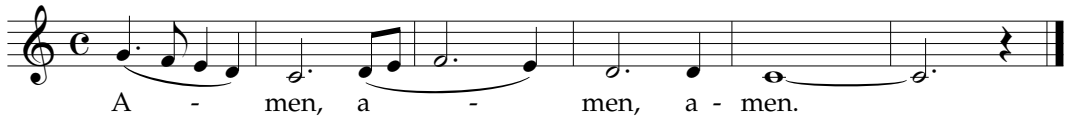
